- #BeHereAlamo Career Posters: Sets of 12 posters have been included in your kit and should be displayed around your building. These posters are meant to show students that they need to be in school to reach their career goals.

- "I go to school every day because..." Posters: Three laminated fill-in-the-blank posters are included. Ask students why they come to school every day and have them write their answers with a dry-erase marker on the poster. (Note: Laminated posters must be cleaned thoroughly after each use to ensure they can be used as long as possible.)

Sunset Hills Elementary School and Holloman Middle School were recognized for having the best attendance rate in the district.

Yucca Elementary School was recognized for its most improved attendance rate, improving to 3% at the requested 5% reporting period. Mountain View Middle School was recognized as the secondary school with the most improved attendance rate. They went from a 9% excessive absence rate to 6%.
